We need to continue to invest in t ball and clinic.

We had double the amount of late registrations this year. Need to make an effort to get multiple email blasts out earlier and impose a late fee.

Payments for registration will be going through the new RPYBSL website starting next rec season.

In talks with KLL to get away from google docs to another online platform, similar to RecDesk but free, that requires payment at time of registration. General idea is to open the registration window up later, for a shorter time, and impose late fees. All for next rec season, summer and fall continue with google docs.
