Fiscal Business:

Funds are currently low, however we had a lot of up front costs with the tournament. Checks have not been posted from registration, fall ball tournament fees, and snack stand revenue which are still to be deposited(close to \$20,000).

Keith Hoffman confirmed that we will receive a check \$7,200 for field usage.

Scheduling:

-Halloween tournament was a huge success.

-Kenilworth does not want 6/7/8th grade softball for recreation. We will absorb the players from Kenilworth to give them a place to play(19 girls given an opportunity to play).

-Travel tryouts for softball will take place on 11/22 or 11/23, girls must be registered due by 11/14 for spring. Payments are due by December 1st.

-Boys baseball will use google form to sign up for tryouts and payments will be submitted online through a vendor(Sports Connect).

-Baseball travel tryouts-1/31 and 2/1

-Rec evaluations-2/28 for baseball and 3/1 for softball. All players will be present.

Maintenance:

- Tractors need to go out for repairs. Voted Yeah (\$2000)
- A new infield Lip is being cutout and cleaned up. Voted Yeah(\$3000)
- Tournament was a huge success.
- We need to fill in the dip on wolf behind 1st base.
- New lights for the kitchen have arrived
- Electric bill yearly average payment was less then it was last year from \$1,800 down to \$250
- Field cleanup will be announced soon.

Registration:

- Boys travel fees will increase from (8/9/10 age group)185-200\$ and (11-12 age group)200-225\$.
- Girls will remain at \$175 for travel.
- Kenilworth wants to collect late fees. We are in favor of a \$25 late fee.
- We will do Cal Ripkin in the summer for baseball instead of Little League. We will charter a team as Roselle Park in order to secure an opportunity for our baseball players to play in.

Sponsorship:

- Outreach for sponsors will begin as soon as the former list is provided.
- 4x8 banners will no longer be used.
- Plaques will be brought back this year.

Additional Business:

- Workbonds hours have mostly been accounted for and honored.
- Dugout repairs are being pursued in conjunction with the town.
